
We do want to hear from everyone and so does the Lord. It really is a sacred duty to support the Church and to be actively involved in your Faith. We would like you all to respond by either renewing the commitments that you have made in the past or currently participate in, or by signing up for new ministries that interest you. With the forms, you can simply end your participation in a ministry by not putting a check mark by the ministry name.

When you make your Time Commitment, I simply ask that you find your way to spend time with God and your Faith. For many that is done at home and there is space to write in what you do. “I will pray the rosary each day,” “I will read the Bible for ten minutes each day,” “I will attend an education class or the Parish Picnic or play soccer.” Whether you do these at Church or at home, please make your commitment.

For your Talent Commitment, I invite you to find a ministry or two that really interests you and sign up for it. Many ministries do not entail meetings or training – a few do. Some are simple to do; e.g., the Elijah Cup, bringing up the gifts at the Offertory, etc. Some place a serious demand on your time and talents; e.g., being a RE Catechist or serving on the Pastoral Council. Please find your way. If you are homebound, please pray for the parish, and if you would for me, as your ministry.

Finally, I am inviting you again to make a Treasure Commitment this year. If the Lord has been generous to you, could you respond generously to the support of His work through the Church? If you are struggling in these poor economic times, I would simply ask that you consider making a sacrificial offering appropriate to your circumstances. Treasure pledge forms will be sent in a separate mailing.
