

A PILGRIMAGE TO PARIS, FATIMA, LOURDES & LA SALETTE

SUNDAY & MONDAY, MAY 20TH & 21ST, 2018: DEPART USA ARRIVE IN LISBON - LISBON & FATIMA

Arrive in Lisbon and be welcomed at the airport by your guide-tour leader. Transfer to Fatima enjoying lunch (on your own) along the way. Visit the shrine of Our Lady of Fátima and discover the chapel of the apparitions and the basilica of Our Lady of the Rosary where you can see Francisco and Jacinta's graves, Aljustrel, the village of shepherds, Loca do Anjo, and Valinhos, the places of the apparitions. Check into your hotel for dinner and overnight.

TUESDAY, MAY 22ND 2018: FATIMA, BRAGA & SANTIAGO

After breakfast at your hotel, transfer to Braga. Visit the sanctuary of Bom Jesus, a worship place for the Passion. Traditionally, pilgrims would go through the stairs of the five senses and the stairs of three virtues on their knees before entering the church. Once inside, the pilgrims would provide their weight in candle using a scale which is still on display today. Celebrate Mass! After lunch on your own, transfer to Santiago de Compostela, Spain. Walk the medieval streets of Santiago, declared one of the three major pilgrimage sites of Christianity by Pope Alexander VI in 1492. Over 200,000 pilgrims a year come to pray on the tomb of Saint James the Great. Discover the Obradoiro square and the splendid cathedral dedicated to Saint Jacques, patron saint of Spain. Check into your hotel for dinner and overnight.

WEDNESDAY, MAY 23RD 2018: SANTIAGO, VALLADOLID & AVILA

After breakfast, enjoy your scenic drive to Valladolid. Enjoy lunch on your own before discovering the amazing gothic church of Santa Maria la Antigua built in the 14th century on the remains of an old Romanesque church. Continue to and visit the birthplace of Saint Teresa. Stroll through the narrow streets of the old city and soak up its unique atmosphere. Discover the monastery of the Incarnation where Saint Teresa took her vows and where she lived the experience of Transverberation. The chapel and a small museum hold precious objects which belonged to Saint Teresa. Dinner and overnight in Avila.

THURSDAY, MAY 24TH 2018: AVILA, SARAGOSSE & BARCELONA

After breakfast, transfer to Saragosse. Visit the basilica of Our Lady of the Pillar, one of the largest religious buildings in Spain. Here, the Virgin appeared to the Apostle Jacques in 40 A.D. to encourage him on his way of evangelizing Europe. Saint Jacques first built a chapel dedicated to the Virgin making this the oldest Marian shrine of the Christendom. After lunch on your own, continue to Barcelona to check into your hotel for dinner and overnight.

FRIDAY, MAY 25TH 2018 : BARCELONA, MONTSERRAT & LOURDES

After breakfast, tour the old city of Barcelona. Walk the famous Rambla, this pedestrian avenue built in a former river bed stretches from the old harbour and the column of Christopher Columbus stretching to Plaça Catalunya. South of the Rambla, the narrow streets of the Gothic Quarter reflect the medieval past of the city. Visit of the basilica of the Sagrada Familia (Unesco). Though unfinished, this masterpiece started in 1892, by Antoni Gaudi, is the landmark of the city. Transfer to the mountains of Montserrat and visit of the monastery of Saint Mary. Enjoy lunch on your own before continuing to Lourdes for dinner and overnight.

SATURDAY, MAY 26TH 2018 : LOURDES

After breakfast, begin your day of pilgrimage at the sanctuary of Our Lady of Lourdes, the doorway to the Pyrenees mountain chain. It is here that the Virgin Mary appeared to the uneducated shepherdess as the Immaculate Conception. Today the grotto where the apparitions took place is a sanctuary of prayer for all the pilgrims who flock here. Everyone is allowed to take some water from Lourdes for healing oneself or a friend. Next, walk in the footsteps of Bernadette and visit Boly mill where she grew up and the Cachot where her family later moved. The museum of the miraculously healed and the examining office, in the confines of the sanctuary, are there to attest to the authenticity of the healing miracles that happen on these grounds. You may also choose to participate in a time of prayer at the grotto of the apparitions, walk the way of the cross, go to the baths, see a movie about the story of Saint Bernadette, go to confession or participate in the candle-light procession. Lourdes is the third most visited pilgrimage site in the world and the second most visited town in France after Paris. Enjoy lunch on your own. This afternoon attend Mass and enjoy some free time before returning to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

SUNDAY, MAY 27TH 2018 : LOURDES, CARCASSONNE & AVIGNON

After breakfast, transfer to Carcassonne and celebrate Mass. Next, discover the fortified city of Carcassonne. This exceptionally well preserved and beautiful city will give you an idea of what it would have been like to live in the Middle Ages. Situated in the south of France, not far from the Mediterranean Sea and the Pyrenees Mountains, Carcassonne is a Unesco as a World Heritage site. After lunch on your own, continue to Avignon, the "European capital of culture". Visit the famous papal palace, listed by Unesco as a World Heritage site. Avignon became the seat of the papacy between 1309 and 1423 before they returned to Rome. Check into your hotel for dinner and overnight.

MONDAY, MAY 28TH 2018 : AVIGNON, LA SALETTE & GRENOBLE

After breakfast, transfer to La Salette. Situated at an elevation of 1800 m in the Hautes-Alpes south of Grenoble is the sanctuary of Our Lady of la Salette, the 2nd most visited one in France after Lourdes. In 1846, the Virgin Mary appeared to, Maximin and Mélanie, two shepherd children living in the area. Enjoy lunch on your own. This afternoon, have the rosary hour before departing for Grenoble for dinner and overnight.

TUESDAY, MAY 29TH 2018 : GRENOBLE, ARS-SUR-FORMANS, PARAY-LE-MONIAL, NEVERS & PARIS

After breakfast, transfer to Ars-sur-Formans where you will discover the life and influence of Saint Curé d'Ars (patron saint of priests). The life of devotion of Saint Curé d'Ars and his love for the "Good God" -as he liked to call him- transformed the life of the inhabitants of the village of Ars and beyond. You can pray at his shrine, visit his house, pray in the company of the dynamic religious community and deepen the still very relevant message of the saint. Continue to Paray-le-Monial, and evoke the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The sanctuary is administered by the community of the Emmanuel which spreads the message of the infinite love of Jesus throughout the world. View a presentation of the apparitions and the message of the Christ and have a time of prayer. After lunch on your own, continue to Nevers. Pilgrimage to the sanctuary of Nevers dedicated to Saint Bernadette of Lourdes. After her life in Lourdes, Bernadette joined the congregation of the sisters of charity, in Nevers where she lived for 13 years. After your visit in Nevers, head to Paris where you will check into your hotel for dinner and overnight.

WEDNESDAY, MAY 30TH 2018 : PARIS & LISIEUX

After breakfast, transfer to Lisieux for a day of pilgrimage. Discover the basilica and watch a movie about the life of Saint Therese. Visit of the "Buissonnets", the family home where Saint Therese spent her childhood, and discover the Carmelite convent where she remained cloistered until her death. Have a time of prayer by the relics at her shrine. Next, visit the Cathedral of Saint Peter where the Martin family regularly attended Mass. After lunch on your own, return to Paris and visit the basilica of the Sacred Heart of Montmartre. Take in the amazing view of Paris from here. Tradition holds that Saint Denis, the first bishop of Paris, and his companions, died as martyrs here giving Montmartre its name "the mount of martyrs". Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

THURSDAY, MAY 31ST 2018 : PARIS

After breakfast, visit the Notre-Dame Cathedral, a jewel of gothic art. Discover this unique site which is still a place of rich spirituality and symbol of Paris and of Christian France. Next, visit the chapel of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal where several apparitions of the Virgin Mary took place. At this place of peace and silence in the heart of Paris, discover the life of Saint Catherine Labouré to whom the Virgin Mary appeared. Celebrate Mass! Just a few blocks away, discover the chapel of Saint Vincent de Paul, known not only as a champion of the poor but also of the rich, for he taught them to do works of mercy. After lunch on your own, visit the Eiffel tower for pictures before returning to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

FRIDAY, JUNE 1ST 2018: RETURN HOME

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your return flight home.

REGISTRATIONS RECEIVED AFTER FEBRUARY 4, 2018:

We welcome registrations after 2/4/18. Registrations received between 2/5/18 - 2/19/18 will incur a \$100 per person fee. Registrations received between 2/20/18 - 3/6/18 will incur a \$200 per person fee. Registrations received between 3/7/18 - 3/21/18 will incur a \$400 per person fee. Registrations received on 3/22/18 or later will incur an additional fee based on air availability. Additional fees will be advised upon registration.

CANCELLATION FEES:

100% of Cancellation Fees are covered by the optional Travel Protection Program, provided premium has been paid and reason for cancellation is insurable. Those who do not take travel protection should be aware of the following cancellation penalties: From day of registration to 105 days prior to departure, you will be charged the \$100 non-refundable administrative fee plus any airline fees. Additionally, thereafter, you will be charged any airline penalties and a single room supplement if your cancellation forces your roommate into a single plus the following charges: 104-60 days = \$400; 59-45 days = \$600; 44-31 days = 40% of total cost; 30 days to day of departure = 100% of total cost. Submit cancellation in writing. On or after day of departure, there will be no refund for any services not used.

FIT TO TRAVEL STATEMENT:

Passengers registering for the tour accept the responsibility for being in good health and able to walk and travel on the tour. Because many of the sites are not accessible to the physically challenged, those needing oxygen, wheelchairs, or other ambulatory assistance will find the tour extremely limiting to their experiences.

PASSPORT INFORMATION, CONFIRMATION OF ITINERARY & CHECK IN PROCESS:

Passport information must be submitted to our office no later than 2/4/18. Failure to provide your passport information to our office by this date may result in change fees or denial of travel. Approximately 105 days prior to your trip you will be contacted to re-confirm your itinerary, travel arrangements and registration information during the preliminary check in process for your trip. Discrepancies in information or failure to check in for your tour may result in change fees, delays in receiving travel documents for your trip, or denial of travel.

PRICE INCREASES:

All prices quoted in this brochure are subject to change prior to payment in full due to currency fluctuations, fuel surcharge increases, government taxes and fees increases or unforeseen circumstances. In addition, you may be subject to a price increase after payment in full has been received due to potential government imposed taxes and fees.

AIRLINE ROUTES and TICKETS:

In order to keep prices low, we do not guarantee the most direct routing to your final destination. Once "printed", airline tickets cannot be changed or refunded thereafter. Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class on IATA and ARC carriers utilizing APEX or SUPER APEX non-refundable, non-amendable tickets for groups of 10 or more flying together on entire itinerary. If you depart from a different city than your group or travelling companion, or you are taking a pre or post tour, you may fly on a different scheduled flight.

FLIGHT TIMES:

All flights are subject to change by the airlines without advance notice. We are not responsible for such changes or delays and does not reimburse expenses resulting from such delays.
